**Your Church needs you!** Can you help or do you know someone who may be encouraged to serve Trinity as a member of Church Council? Please give this matter your prayerful consideration. Each year, four places are available for members to serve on Church Council for a period of 3 years. In addition there are two vacancies, one to serve for 1 year and one for 2 years. Church Council is our governing body **and this is an opportunity for members to make a real contribution to the life of Trinity.**

Nominations for this year's election are invited from Sunday 3rd June and will close on Sunday 17th June. Any member of Trinity, over 18 years of age, is eligible to serve on Church Council. Members may be nominated by another member, or may nominate themselves. Nominations should be sent to Peter Short, c/o Trinity Church Office.

Candidates will be asked to supply a brief self-profile which will be published, together with a photograph, before the election. The ballot will take place during morning worship on Sunday 15th July; "postal voting" is not available. Results will be announced at the Congregation AGM on Saturday, 28th July. New members of Church Council will serve from 1st September. *Peter Short, Senior Steward.*
