‘The Trinity Victory (ia) sponge recipe’

For interest to those who were impressed with our collective efforts the other Sunday morning. How to bake a cake:

Set the oven to gas mark 4, 180 C or 160 C fan.

Bring weighed ingredients to church: 6oz baking spread, 6oz of sugar, 6oz self-raising flour with 1.5 teaspoons of baking powder dropped in, 3 medium eggs (free range of course). Place spread on a radiator so it is very warm and runny when you need it.

An 8” baking tin, lined with greased paper. Along with mixing bowl, whisk and aprons.

Start to worship, then get some willing volunteers to bung all the ingredients into the bowl in one go – please remember to take eggs out of the shells first. Mix with whisk for about 40 seconds then pour into baking tin.

Leave to stand while singing a few more worship songs then hand over to volunteers to take the cake and put in oven for 25 minutes. Trust someone to remember to keep an eye on and get out when ready. Meanwhile continue to worship. After the Service cut horizontally in half and spread some plum jam on. Cut into small slices and stand back so you don’t get trampled.
